



NOTICE OF RETIREE ELECTION

Police and Fire Retirement Board Fire Department Retiree Representative

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with the San José Municipal Code and the election procedure established by the City Council, an election will be held on Monday, December 6, 2010, for the following purpose: recommending to the City Council one retiree representative who is a retired member of the **Fire Department** under the Police and Fire Department Retirement Plan to serve on the Board of Administration for said retirement system for a term which expires November 30, 2014.

Eligible candidates may, not earlier than 8:00 a.m., Monday, September 27, 2010, or later than 5:00 p.m., Friday, October 15, 2010, file in the Office of the City Clerk a nomination petition for office. The petition form, which will be available on and after September 27, 2010, shall be obtained from the Office of the City Clerk and shall be signed by at least ten (10) eligible retired members of the Fire Department. Nominations may not be withdrawn after the close of the nomination period. No one retiree may sign more than one nomination petition for a given office.

Candidates' statements of qualifications, prepared in accordance with Section 7.1 of the election procedure, may be filed with the City Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m., Friday, October 15, 2010.

ELIGIBILITY RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- **Candidates:** For the Police and Fire Department Retirement Board (P&F), **only Fire Department** retirees who are receiving retirement allowances from the P&F as of August 1, 2010 shall be eligible to run.
- **Petition Signers:** Only Fire Department retirees who are receiving retirement allowances from P&F as of August 1, 2010, shall be eligible to sign nomination petitions of candidates for the Board.
- **Voters:** Only Police or Fire retirees who are receiving retirement allowances from P&F both as of August 1, 2010 and as of the date the ballot is cast, shall be eligible to vote.

Ballots for these elections will be mailed to eligible voters on November 5, 2010. Any questions about the nomination or election procedure may be referred to the Office of the City Clerk, (408) 535-1252 or by e-mail: cityclerk@sanjoseca.gov
