NOVEMBER IS OPEN ENROLLMENT MONTH

November is Open Enrollment month for City of San José retirees. During November you will have the opportunity to:

- Change your medical, dental, and/or vision plans
- Re-enroll if you have dropped your medical, dental, and/or vision coverage
- Add qualified dependents to your medical, dental, and/or vision plans

Open Enrollment change requests must be submitted to Retirement Services by <u>November 30, 2010</u>. To enroll On-Line, visit our website at <u>www.sjretirement.com</u>. Changes will become effective January 1, 2011.

<u>Please Note:</u> Open Enrollment information will be mailed to all qualifying retirees the last week in October. If you do not receive the information, call us at (408) 794-1000 or toll free at (800) 732-6477, to request that a packet be sent to you, or visit our website www.sjretirement.com.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT PREMIUMS AND NEW CO-PAYMENTS

Starting January 1, 2011, new options for non-Medicare eligible retirees have been added for both Kaiser Permanente and Blue Shield with reduced premiums and increased co-pays. A comparison chart will be included with the Open Enrollment packet. Take a minute to review the changes so you can be informed.

HEALTH CARE REFORM CHANGES

One provision extends health coverage to dependents until their 26th birthday, regardless of student, employment, residential or marital status. This coverage is not automatic. You must take action to reenroll eligible dependents by completing the open enrollment form and submitting it no later than November 30, 2010. The full-time student guidelines still apply for dental, vision, and life insurance coverage.

The lifetime limits on the dollar value of benefits under the Blue Shield, PacifiCare, and Secure Horizon plans no longer apply. Individuals whose coverage ended by reason of reaching a lifetime limit under these plans are eligible to enroll. You may request enrollment during the open enrollment period by completing and submitting the open enrollment form no later than November 30, 2010.

OPEN ENROLLMENT REMINDER

Full-Time Students for Dental, Vision, and Life Insurance Coverage

Dependent children between the ages of 19 and 24 must be unmarried and enrolled as full-time students (12 units or more at an accredited school). You must provide enrollment verification if you wish to enroll or maintain coverage for a full-time student. Verification must be submitted **every semester/quarter** to maintain coverage. Child dependents are dropped from coverage when they fail to furnish full time student verification or when they graduate, and are dropped automatically the last day of the month s/he turns age 24.

Representatives from your health, dental, and vision plans will be available at the Retirement Services office on Tuesday, November 16, 2010, to answer retirees' plan-specific questions through out the duration of the Health Fair. The Health Fair is scheduled from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm in the Board Room located at 1737 North First Street, Suite 600, 6th Floor, San José, CA.

NEW ~ VOLUNTARY INSURANCE BENEFITS

Starting January 1, 2011, Trustmark Insurance Company will be offering voluntary insurance benefits including Critical Illness with a Cancer Rider and Accident insurance policies. If you are 64 years old or younger and would like more information, please contact an Enrollment Counselor by calling (866) 998-2915, Monday – Friday, 5am – 5pm PST to schedule an appointment or visit their website www.myenrollmentschedule.com/sanjose to schedule an appointment. Enrollment must be completed by November 30, 2010.

FLU SHOTS -Why get vaccinated against the flu?

Anyone can catch a flu virus. Most people will feel ill for a few days and suffer fever, sore throat, chills, fatigue and cough. Flu can lead to pneumonia and can be dangerous for people with heart, breathing conditions or a compromised immune system. Every year about 36,000 people die in the United States, mostly the elderly, from complications related to influenza. You can be infected by the influenza virus – but not feel ill – and pass the virus to your family, friends and co-workers, or other people who have a high risk of complications.

Retirement Services has the Kaiser Permanente Injection Team scheduled to come to our Health Fair on November 16th from 10am to 2pm to provide combined **FREE** H1N1 and "seasonal" flu shot to retirees and employees. Even if you are not a Kaiser member, you can still get a **FREE** flu shot. Blue Shield will be paying for half the costs of the flu shots.

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In Retirement What Should be Important to You

What is the most important aspect of your life when you retire? Is it your finances? Is it your companions? Or, is it simply your health? You've led a busy life prior to your retirement and maybe you haven't taken very good care of your health. With your retirement starting this is a good time to make your health one of your priorities. After all if you are eligible you have selected the heath plan that is best for you and your situation. You should make use of this superior benefit.

What can you do? See your doctor for important preventive screenings and adult immunizations. Prevention is the best way to keep from getting sick or to find diseases early, when they are easier to treat.

Talk to your doctor about getting the following screenings:

- Blood pressure, body mass index and more
- Cholesterol
- Abdominal aortic aneurysm (If you are between ages 65 and 75 and have ever smoked ask your doctor about being screened once.)
- Colorectal cancer (different testing options are available. Talk to your doctor about which test is right for you)

This is only a suggestive list. The most important thing that you can do is talk to your doctor and schedule regular physicals.

Ask your doctor if you are due for any of the following immunizations:

- Annual flu shot
- Pneumonia—for people with chronic conditions and all adults age 65 and older
- TD booster (tetanus and diphtheria) every 10 years
- Zostavax (shingles) age 60 and older

These tips are based on nationally recognized guidelines. For questions about preventive health benefits call the customer services number for your plan. The number is located on your insurance card.

Web Member Services (WMS) can be accessed via the internet - www.sjretirement.com. The secured portal allows you to access your personal data including:

Here's a guide on how to gain access to your personal information:

- 1. Go to www.sjretirement.com and click on your Retirement Plan
- 2. Select the "My Account" button from the menu on the left. First time users will be guided through the creation of a user id and password by clicking on 'Need an account'.
- 3. Log in to access your own information. (If you don't know your username and password call Barbara Hayman 408-794-1026 or May Cheung 408-794-1027 or Gina Billings 408-794-1025 during business hours.)

On the left side you will find a menu listing of all your available selections.

If you are a retiree and would like to **Go Green** take advantage of our Online Open Enrollment feature this year – get your WMS username and password account details now – you'll be asked to log in to WMS to access the online open enrollment form. Note: The Open Enrollment period runs from Nov 1st – Nov 30th.
