



Office of Retirement Services Medicare Transition Guidelines

City of San José requires its retirees to enroll in Medicare Part A and B at age 65. Retirees who were hired prior to **March 3, 1986** are not required to enroll in Medicare Part, A unless they qualify for Part A at no cost. Such members must submit a copy of their Medicare Award letter, stating Medicare Part A ineligibility, along with a copy of their Medicare Part B only card. **All spouses and dependents wishing to continue health coverage past age 65 must enroll in Part A and Part B.**

Retirees who were hired on/after March 3, 1986 are required to enroll in both Medicare Part A and B. Please visit our website for more information on the Medicare transition process and requirements.

Please note: Kaiser’s Senior Advantage Plan **has Medicare zip code service area requirements**. Please visit the Medicare Health Plans page to verify zip code eligibility prior to submitting enrollment forms. The insurance provider **WILL NOT** be able to process your enrollment if your zip code is not within the applicable zip code service area list.
