Subject: Fire Tier 1 with Healthcare Retirement Contribution Rates

The Board of Administration for the Police and Fire Department Retirement Plan (Retirement Board) approved new Retirement Contribution Rates for the fiscal year 2021-2022. The Retirement Contribution Rate is the percentage of your salary that you and the City pay into the Retirement Plan.

These rates are effective Pay Period 14 (June 27, 2021); with a pay date of July 16, 2021.
